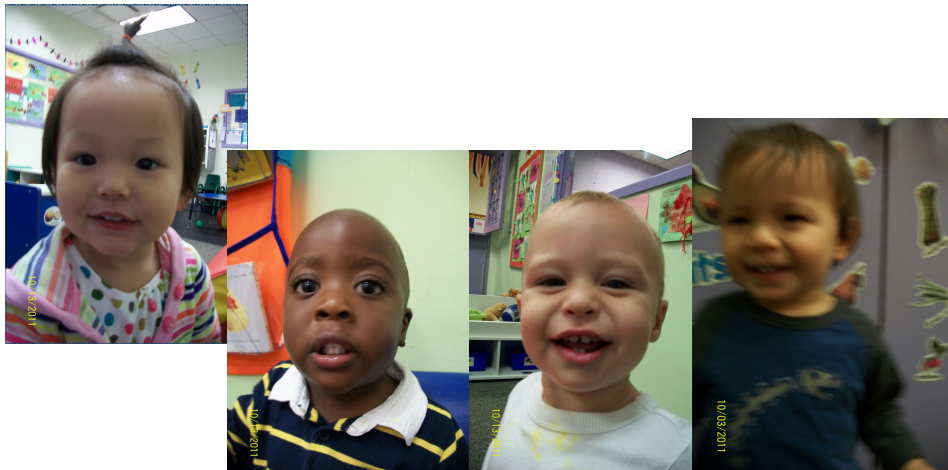




Hippo Happenings
