WOW. . . We Can't Wait to Explore!

Math: In the math area, we are planning on counting teeth to practice our counting and one to one correspondence skills, using floss as a form of measurement, creating different patterns with plastic toothbrushes, putting paper heart puzzles together, making patterns with our friends (boy, girl, boy, girl), using chocolate chips to help us work on our counting and grouping skills, sorting out different colored stripes and sorting objects by color...we are going to be super busy and working on LOTS of math skills during the month of February!

Science: Hooray for new science activities! What's on our agenda this month? Well, we are going to be mixing baking soda and water together to try to create our own toothpaste, putting our hands inside our feely box to try to recognize what is inside by just using our sense of touch (no peeking!), finding hidden objects inside our sensory table, placing white carnations in water and adding food coloring to see if the flowers change colors, creating people and friends out of playdough, mixing dirt and water to create "pigs in mud", practicing our measuring, scooping and mixing skills, exploring our environment with magnifying glasses and even making time to discover objects that are hard vs. soft.

Literacy: Letters, words and discussions...OH MY! We are hoping to sharing experiences about our times at the dentist office, learning the sequence of how to brush our teeth (brush, toothpaste, water and in mouth!), having discussions about cavities, how we celebrate Valentines Day, identifying letters on candy hearts, creating a chart of our favorite cookies, thinking of words that rhyme, writing letters and creating letters out of a goldfish snack!

Art: Paints, markers, crayons and more! We LOVE the art center! We can't wait to create happy smiles, making popcorn tooth faces, practicing our snipping skills, using dental floss as a painting tool, creating our own Valentine Day cards, making a friendship mural, sponge painting people, making balloon prints, creating art with real syrup, some egg roll painting, marble art, using bubble wrap to create fish prints and finding only the color green to make our own collage...so much to look forward to in the month of February...W00 H00!


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
