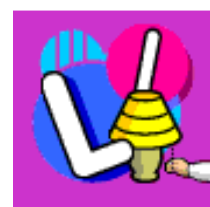
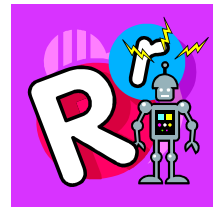

What's Happening in the Rhinos?!

Math: For our Travel unit, friends will use transportation counters to count simple math. Rhinos will also use our transportation toys to create patterns and to work on fine motor skills and memory. Our friends are working on developing their math skills and perfecting their adding and subtracting! Were hoping this week gives them an opportunity to really get flying in the air!

Science: For our Fur, Feathers & Fins week, Rhinos will experiment with different items to see which ones fall faster than the other. Rhinos will also look at footprints and make observations using visual clues and discussion. Using our sensory table, friends will explore the method of sink or swim and make predictions on different toys and whether they will sink or swim. 😊

Literacy: During our Camping unit, friends discussed as a group what they would bring if they were going camping! Rhinos also talked about where they like to sleep whether it be in their bed, on the couch or under the beautiful night sky with all the stars. During this week, friends will also discuss and think about why fires can be dangerous in certain settings especially forest fires!

Art: During our Summer Fun week, Rhinos will use their FEET as tools to paint unique and creative pictures! Friends will also make yummy watermelon pictures using glue, paint and scissors. Rhinos are going to be using different tools other than their feet to make pictures such as popsicle sticks and grass pieces! We are sure our friends will have a fun time! 😊

(Bring one hand to the front with your pointer finger extended.)**

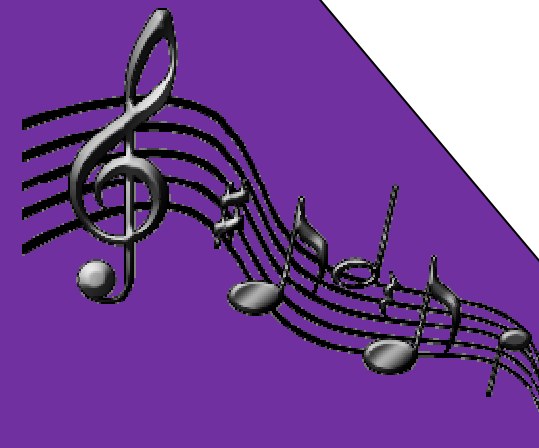
**One named Jill
