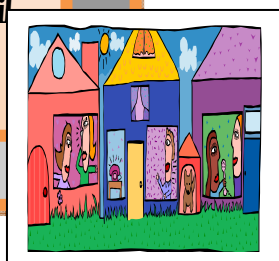
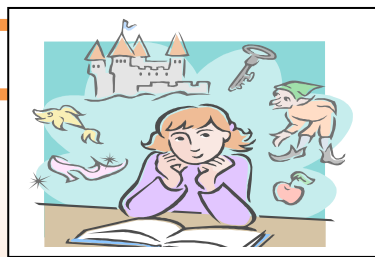

WOW... We Can't Wait to Explore!

Math: This month the Zebras will practice counting using transportation counters to solve simple math problems, create patterns using classroom toys, write numerals using the sand like a material to feel textures, use discriminatory skills while counting continents, group and sequence items according to size, search for numbers in our environment, put sorting shapes to group items together, focusing in determine distance using a ruler, measure, compare and contrast ourselves “how tall am I, how big are my feet”, count and identify the number of letters in name, meatball match to practicing match numerals to objects.

Science: We will have the opportunity to use our fingers sense to create puffy paint using water, flour, salt and food coloring, also to identify texture letters using the sense of touch, and explore variety of familiar textures using hands, explore in the sensory table to search for and find common shapes hidden in a texture material, use an egg to demonstrate fine motor control while exploring parts the parts, use hands and light to create objects, taste testing to discover new things using the sense of taste, name sound to identify sounds using only sense of hearing, use a fruit like an orange to explore inside and out.

Literacy: Our friends will learn this month what America means, create simple words using letter stamps, “look, listen, and match familiar pictures and sounds with words, demonstrate “upper” or “lower” case, create letters using red, white, and blue yarn, we will discuss about distance “far, farther, farthest”, the Zebras will use their imagination to create a list about what did they know , also we will practice rhyming words, and use spaghetti letters to create own names!

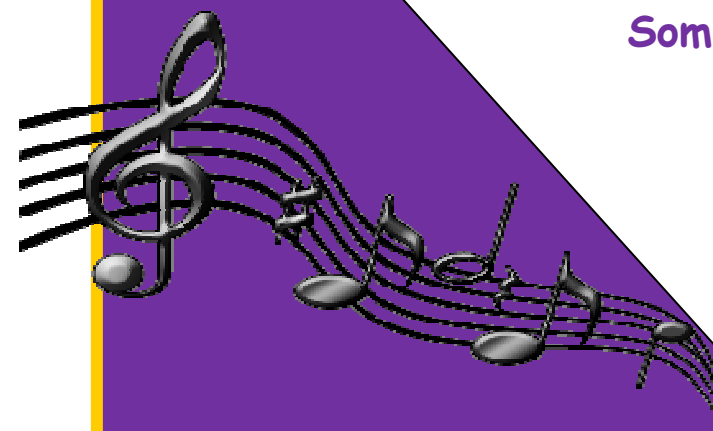
Art: What a fun can be art time! The Zebras will use pasta to paint it using red, white, and blue paint to make a necklaces to demonstrate lacing skills, and also to create patriotic letters, they have to use their imagination to create a map using markers and crayons, create puppets using paper bags, they needs to demonstrate how creative they are to draw an own fish, one of our fun art will be a “goldfish ocean animal” with it they will create an ocean animal using food, to “never, neverland” they will use materials to create a kite, trace and create their bodies, create license plate using letter stampers, and create playground prints using playground items like a mulch, balls, etc!

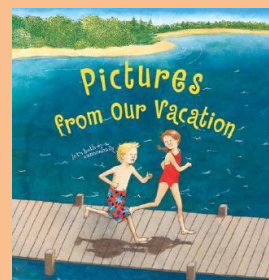
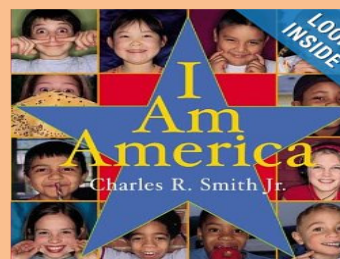

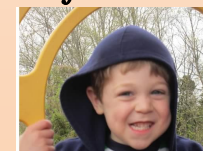
