WOW. . . We Can't Wait to Explore!

Math: In the math area, we are planning on exploring shamrocks during our St. Patrick's Day week! We also want to compare sizes, matching objects to numerals and more. The Zebras will be counting the letters in words and in our names, we were wanting to make patterns with shamrocks and leprechauns, making letters, doing some finger math, trying to determine length by measuring and grouping/sorting plastic vegetables too!

Science: Our threes will be exploring coffee filters, eyedroppers and food coloring, practicing to mix colors together to create new ones, getting our hands on a green pepper, searching for gold in the sensory table, starting a planting project, reviewing "over and under", "rough and smooth", sorting seeds, putting our hands in colored water, hiding objects in dirt, creating "shadow puppets" and maybe even drawing faces in shaving cream.

Literacy: We can't wait to put on our thinking caps to think about what leprechauns do and what happens on St. Patrick's Day, making a list in print of objects that are green, creating "stamped letters", writing in the color gold, making letters in the sand, creating letters out of hay, exploring stringed letters and thinking of words that rhyme!

Art: "Colors, colors, everywhere, some are here and some are there!" Our art center is always so colorful! We will be using colors and paints to create tulips, veggie prints, marble art, hand tracing, a desert mural, making green collages and foil letters, stamping with green peppers, using scissors to practice our cutting skills, using our feet as a painting tool, getting our fingers "in the mud" and more!

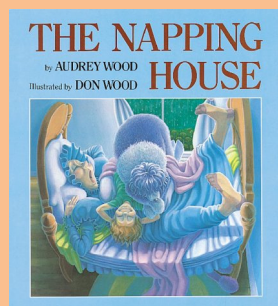
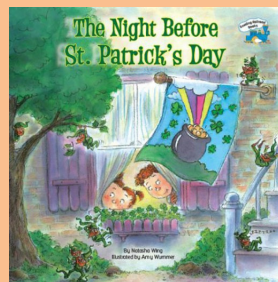
The Zebras Zip
