Math: Hooray for counting, sorting, patterning and more! In the month of December, we will be counting raindrops, making patterns with different types of weather, working on adding and subtracting objects, using the words "more" and "less", counting our fruits and vegetables, creating candle and star patterns and counting down the days until Kwanzaa, Christmas and Hanukkah!

Science: Our science activities will consist of playing a game of "what's that sound?", using only our sense of touch to find out what's inside a stocking, trying new foods during our week of "healthy bodies", drawing ourselves or people in different colors of shaving cream, exploring what happens when you mix water in cornstarch, hiding magnetic letters inside our sensory table, using our feely box and much more!

Literacy: The Zebras are planning on searching around the classroom for the number 8, thinking of words that rhyme with the word "feast", talking about the holidays and traditions that we celebrate in our homes, making a list of our favorite foods, brainstorming and coming up with "healthy" words, looking at uppercase and lowercase letters and discussing weather words too!

Art: Our threes will be creating weather wheels, making cotton ball clouds, painting rainbows with watercolors, using chalk to draw pictures, using the color green to create, using shoes to make prints, creating presents for our friends and family members, exploring colors used in different holidays celebrated around the world and having too much fun!



In the Night Kitchen By: Maurice Sendak


