

What Will Your Panda Explore This Month at Our Learning Centers...

Math: Matching and grouping are important facets of our math curriculum this month; we will do activities such as matching mittens in our Jan Brett theme, and grouping like tools during construction week. Counting and addition are simple equations!

Science: Our friends will be using their senses to explore, such as in activity called "What's inside the egg"? They will also have the opportunity to experiment with fossils and measurement. We can use scales to weigh tools, mix colors to create a new one, and play around with magnets to see how they repel and attract.

<u>Literacy:</u> Our Panda's will be reading a lot of fun books this month, but not only that, they will also be crossing into the frigid arctic by sharing what they would do if they lived in the arctic! Sharing in group discussions and formulating charts to brainstorm are great methods to encourage literacy.

Art: This is always so fun, and this month will be no different! We will be using a diverse set of art tools such as sand, and q-tips to create complex pieces of work. Blending colors to create a mural, and stepping into our favorite animals mask during Jan Brett's theme will be an experience to never forget. Here we go little Van Gohs!


