In our USA theme, we will be using stars and stripes to create patterns too! We will also practice our counting skills by counting shapes and even trying to sort them too! Will we explore sea shells? YES! Will we use our fingers to add and subtract? Yes, yes and another yes!

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




I Read Signs By: Tana Hoban


