Down by the bay?"

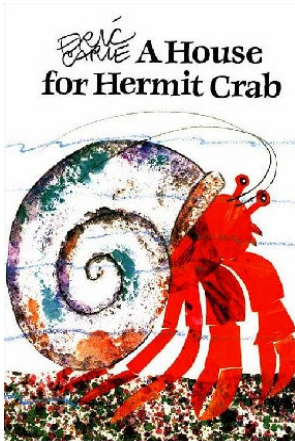

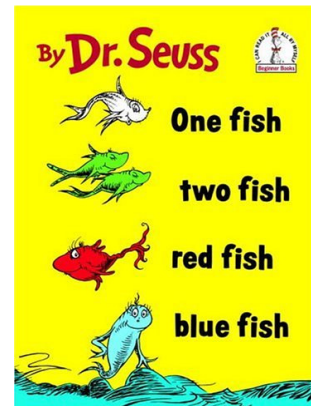
