Math: During the month of March the Pandas will be practicing grouping items according to size, matching objects to numerals, and extending patterns. We will continue practicing writing our numerals, as well as using tools for measuring length and weight.

Science: Our Pandas love being little scientists! Our objectives this month are to explore cause and effect, recording observations through notes and Charts, exploring new textures and materials, and mixing two ingredients to Create a final product.






