Math: Counting, sorting, matching and creating patterns...we have a lot of math activities in store for us! We will be practicing our counting skills by counting shamrocks, counting letters in the words we see, using our unifix cubes to practice patterning, working on different concepts such as big and small, upper and lowercase as well as grouping similar items together to determine which objects are the same and which ones are different.

Science: Mixing colors is always fun and we can't wait to mix yellow and blue together to create GREEN during the week of St. Patrick's Day. One of our favorite things to do is play games of finding hidden objects...maybe we will hide objects around our classroom or hide them in the sensory table...either way, we will search and find things that are hidden from our eyes and it's always a fun time! In the science area, we will also dig for gold, create faces in shaving cream, make shadow puppets with our hands and maybe plant a few seeds to see what will happen next.

Literacy: What kind of literacy activities will we explore? Well, we will think of green objects and create a list in print, use stampers to create letters, try to write letters in sand, think of words that rhyme or sound the same, recalling events from a story and writing about them as well as having lots of discussions about our upcoming themes and making letters around our classroom!

Art: We have many fun activities coming our way this month...we are planning on making green collages, drawing our own Leprechauns, practicing our tracing skills by tracing and cutting horse shoes, exploring sandpaper to create artwork, having our eyes covered with a bandana and create at the same time and much, much more!

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


