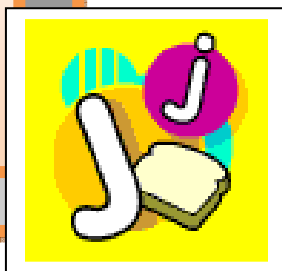


Letters of the Month:

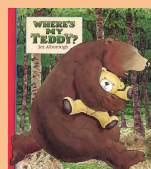

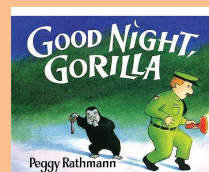
