

What Will Your Panda Explore This Month at our Enrichment Centers?

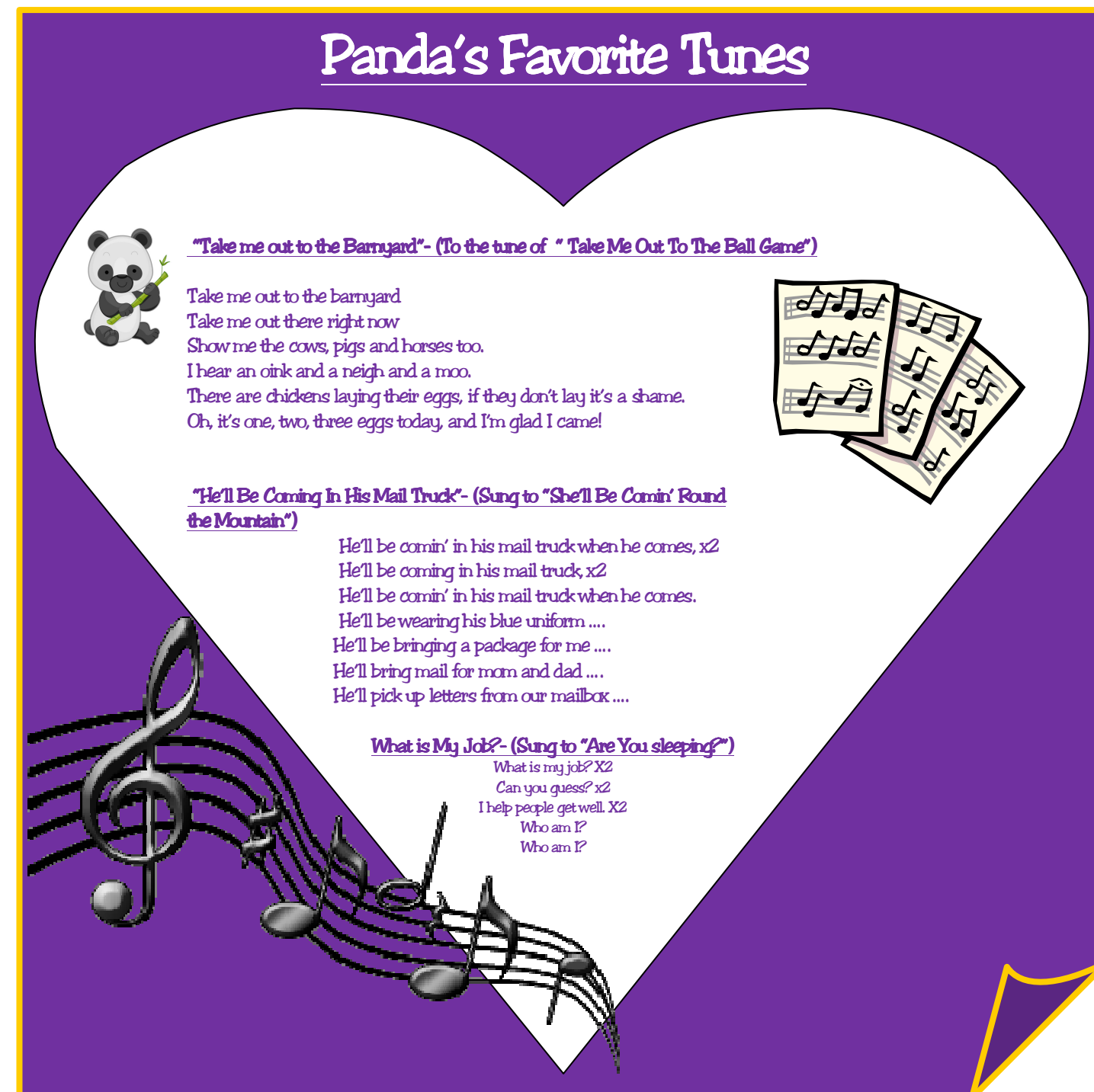
Math: The Panda's will practice one to one correspondence by using toy trains and cars. We'll also practice patterning, sorting, and grouping by posing questions such as ...

- * What kinds of shapes and colors do you see?
- * How many people can fit in a train?
- * How many trains are there?

Science: We continue our Fall season with a ton of exploration! As long as the weather is on our side, we'll be exploring the outdoors and recording our findings. We will introduce different tools such as a thermometer gauge in order to determine changes in temperature. Our Panda's will be able to learn how weather affects farming life and all the different modes of transportation. We will enjoy using our five senses at the water table while participating in a MUD BATH! Our friends will use farm animals and engage in role playing.

Literacy: As we move on to the end of our fall themes and in to our winter ones, they get more exciting and challenging! With our younger Panda's we continue our focus on strengthening both upper and lower case alphabet letters. For our older friends, we are working on mastering alphabet sounds and utilizing new vocabulary in their everyday conversations.

Art: Our friends enjoy hands on activities. So for our upcoming themes they will be able to use a variety of textured materials to create with. Our "Turkeys" theme is a favorite because they practice their fine motor skills by using scissors, glue and other supplies!



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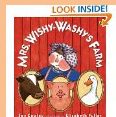
