~ Color bags - the Hippos will mix colors to create new colors. We will make orange from red and yellow and green from blue and yellow by smooshing paint in sealed ziplock bags.

 \sim Acorns in the jar- we will have fun counting acorns when we put them in jar. And we will also explore sounds by shaking them in a jar.

~ Feathers in the sensory table – we will explore textures. The Hippos will touch feathers and feel soft and light they feel. They will also explore what happens when you blow feathers and use simple words such as "up" as they make them fly high.

~ Ice and water – what is colder ice or water? The Hippos will pour water in one container and put some ice in another. We will touch water and ice and talk about the differences!
