Math: In the math area, we are planning on sorting objects into different groups, playing a clown and hat matching game to practice our matching skills, looking at how numbers need to go in a sequence (9-1-1), matching and creating unique patterns with autumn leaves, using a dice to play a dice/leaf pick-up game, making a graph of our favorite Halloween candy and more!

Science: The Zebras will be exploring the power of air (using straws to blow objects), using our sensory table which will be filled up with sand, driving our plastic fire trucks in our shaving cream, mixing colors to create new ones and even creating Halloween shapes with playdough too.

Literacy: We are going to have discussions about circus animals and the tricks that they can do (writing it down on paper), creating a group story on our own, thinking of words that rhyme, making a chart of our Halloween costumes, practicing to make letters in orange sand and writing down our weekend plans.

Art: We have 50 MANY art activities planned for the month of October. Our threes will be drawing their favorite circus animals, creating a circus collage, getting creative with watercolors and paintbrushes, creating fall prints with sponges, using pieces of yarn to make our own spider webs, painting on an easel and using tissues to create ghosts.



Scrarecrow's Hat By: Ken Brown


