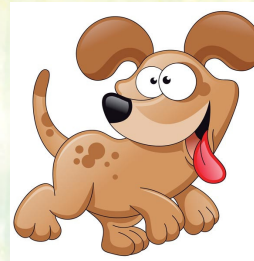
Ten little monkeys jumping on the bed.
