

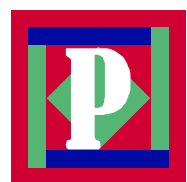

Science: Rhinos can't wait to learn all about apples. They will be using different type of apples for tasting and to explore apple parts.

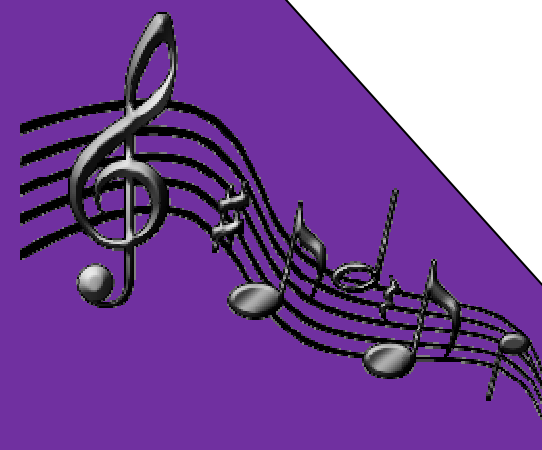
Literacy: Rhinos will talk about houses to identify similarities and differences by comparing pictures.

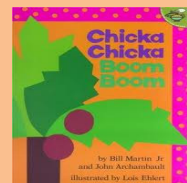
The Rhino Review

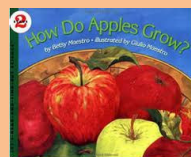
Chicka Chicka Boom Boom

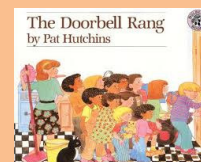
How Do Apples Grow
