WOW... We Can't Wait to Explore!

Math: What will the Zebras do? Well, they will be measuring themselves to see how tall they are, making a list of eye colors in our class, practicing their counting and sorting skill while figuring out how many are in a group. The threes will also be practicing subtraction and addition by using their own bodies, figuring out how many blocks it takes to build a house, using apples to practice counting skills and more!

Science: Our science activities will consist of playing games of "what's missing", exploring our sensory table, going on a number hunt, placing our fingers in shaving cream to draw letters and numbers, exploring new textures and putting our hands inside our feely box to find out what's inside the box...but we can't use our hands, just our sense of touch!

Literacy: We will be making a list of our favorite things we like to do, sharing ideas with our friends, finding name cards outside on the playground, looking at pictures of homes to compare differences and similarities and practicing our writing skills using letter cards, markers and sentence strips.

Art: Our threes will be drawing their most favorite things, using a mirror to draw their self-portrait, using number and letter sponges to create, making a number mural with ink pads and letter/number stampers, creating prints with our plastic keys, exploring golf balls and cotton balls as painting tools, getting creative with apples and paints as well as painting on an easel too!

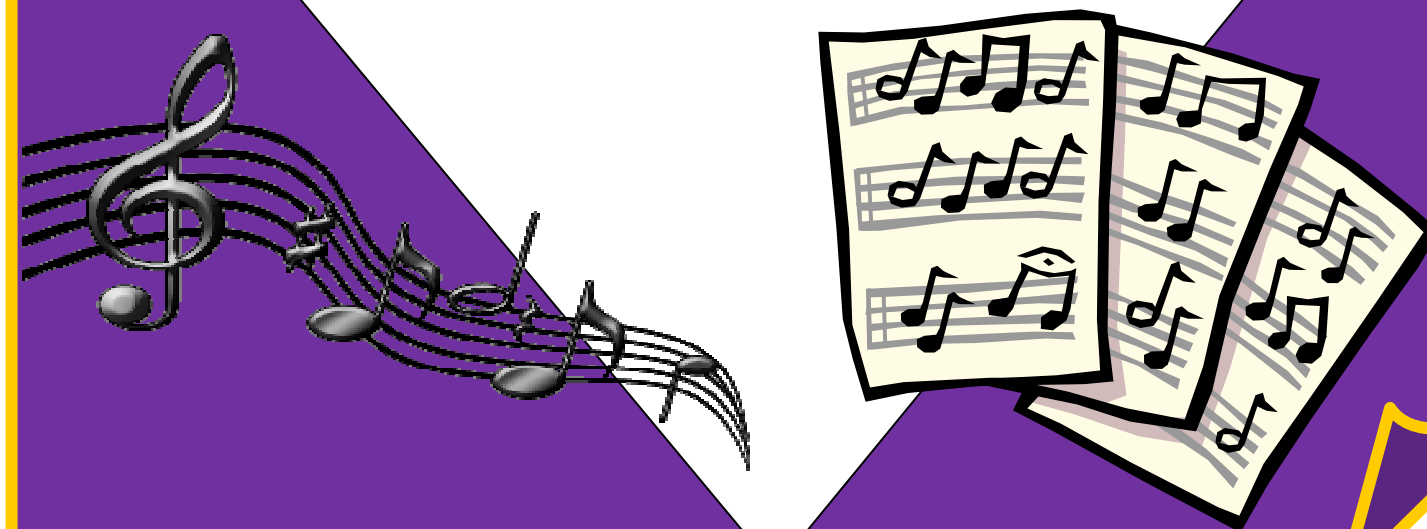
Let us Hear Your Voice...

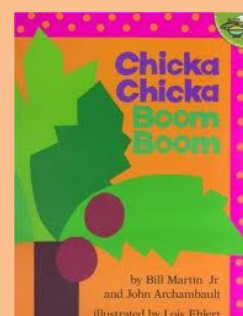
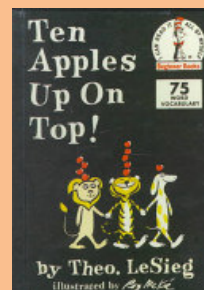
